received **Narcan training** to reverse an overdose, helping keep their peers and community members safe

Those with new job placements are earning **\$19.58 per hour** on average, a nearly **7% increase** over last year



City Beet Kitchens catered **2,411 events**, ranging from intimate lunches to large galas

529 people received vocational training and job placement services



City Beet Kitchens served **1,039,669 meals** to people experiencing homelessness or food insecurity through our own programs and nonprofit partners across the city



Career Advancement Program participants saw a **wage increase averaging \$2,500** more per year



33 students graduated from **Care Corps**, a new mental healthcare job training program launched in partnership with NYC Health + Hospitals

100% of grads from cohort 1 hired by NYC Health + Hospitals were still thriving in their jobs a full year later
